The Holy House and surrounding monastery was destroyed under Henry VIII and was rebuilt by Fr Hope Patten, the local parish Priest, in 1931. The Shrine Accommodation is set at the heart of the village, and has beautiful well-kept grounds, and offers a relaxed and peaceful environment. Moneywise, please note there are NO Banks or ATM-points in Walsingham. Some shops offer the facility of 'cash back'.
